Food, accommodation, and transportation will have to be covered by each individual or organization during their stay in Denpasar, Bali. You may approach the Conference Secretariat if you need any assistance.

INDONESIA/ BALI ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. There are different rules for different foreign visitors to Indonesia. Regardless of what country you are from and what visa you will be getting there are a few things every foreign visitor needs before travelling to Indonesia:

- A passport that is valid for at least 6 months from the day you enter Indonesia
- A passport that has at least one complete blank page

- Proof of a return flight or onward flight out of Indonesia

Indonesian Visa is counted per day, not per night. Your first day and last day are included in the 30 day calculation. Even if you enter Indonesia at 23:55h (11:55pm), the last 5 minutes before midnight will still be considered a full day. The same for your departure.

This visa is for a single entry visit. Every time you exit and re-enter Indonesia you will get a new 30 day free visa.

2. There are the 169 countries that receive an Indonesia **free visa**. Click [here](#) to view the list. This 30 day free Indonesia visa is valid for the purpose of

- Leisure and tourism
- Family
- Social
- Art and Cultural
- Government visits
- Giving a lecture or attend a seminar
- Attend a meeting held by Head office or Representative office in Indonesia
- While in transit on the way to another country

This 30 day free visa cannot be used for journalism. It is not extendable and you cannot convert the visa into a different visa.

3. The **Indonesia visa on arrival** is valid for 30 days. The VOA can be extended by another 30 days while travelling in Indonesia. There are [68 countries](#) that can get a 30 day visa on arrival at USD 35 per person.

This rate is the same for any passenger of any age. Infants need to pay this visa fee as well. The Indonesia visa on arrival can be extended once by another 30 days. The Indonesia visa fee can be paid in cash or credit card. If you pay with cash you can use US Dollars or any other major currency. You will find a piece of paper at the VOA payment counter with the current price in your currency.

4. If your country is **not listed** above then you will need to apply for a visa at the nearest Indonesian Embassy before travelling to Indonesia.

For participants at the official **IMF-World Bank Civil Society Policy Forum, regardless of your nationality**, you need to apply for a conditional visa. Details for the visa procedures for Conditional VOA are found [here](#).

5. If you **overstay** your visa then the official penalty is Rp 300,000 per day you have overstayed. The maximum allowed time you can overstay is 60 days. If you have overstayed your Indonesia

visa for more than 60 then you are in the country without valid visa. The punishment for not having a valid visa is a maximum 5 years sentence or maximum Rp 500,000,000 penalty.

FLIGHT AND HOTEL BOOKINGS

A number of activities are set to happen on October 8; thus we recommend that you arrive the day before.

If you are arriving in Indonesia on October 5 onwards, it is best to take an international flight to Jakarta, and then take a domestic flight from Jakarta to Bali. This way, you have better chances of entering Bali without much hassle, since we expect that the Indonesian government will be implementing strict measures to limit civil society actions in light of the IMF-World Bank meeting in Bali.

Below are some hotels close to the venue. Participants and organizations will need to take care of their own accommodation - from booking to payment.

ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at Ngurah Rai International Airport (Denpasar), Bali, participants must present the following:

1. A valid Passport with an expiration date at least 6 (six) months and contains at least 1 blank visa pages
2. For accredited CSO participants/journalists at the IMF-WB CSPF: letter of Director-General of Immigration and Confirmation letter from the IMF or the WBG Registration Office

Please have your currency exchanged to Indonesian Rupiah (IDR) at the airport to take care of your transportation to the Auditorium RRI and accommodation. The foreign exchange rate is approximately USD 1: IDR 17,787 and may be lower than in the banks in Bali.

You may also purchase a local sim card (indicate price here in USD) at the airport and contact any of the following members of the Secretariat to confirm your arrival and ask for assistance if you need one.

A taxi counter is located outside the arrival area of the airport. You may tell the attendant your destination and pay accordingly.

The cost of taxi ride from Denpasar International Airport to East Denpasar (the location of the venue and hotels) is around IDR 150,000.00 (USD 11.00) to IDR 250,000.00 (USD 17.00)

You may also use the online transportation platform **GO-JEK** or **GRAB**. Please download these applications on your phone. Cost may vary depending on time and availability of service.

We advise everyone to immediately proceed to the Conference venue (Auditorium RRI) on October 10 for the offline registration, settlement of registration fees and initial briefing with the Secretariat.

Also, be aware of your travel time from your accommodation to the venue as we request participants to arrive on time to maximize participation all throughout the Conference.

AT THE MOBILIZATION

Never leave the Peoples' Global Conference group without the knowledge of the team leader, organizers or Secretariat. Follow security protocols (to be given before/during the activity).

You may bring your organizational banner, calls and placards for the march/program. It will also make it easier for the marshals to identify and locate you.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

Climate. The average temperature in October is between 23 – 31 degrees Celsius. Some rainfall, high heat and humidity may also be expected. It will be practical to have an umbrella.

What to wear

Bali is an international tourist destination where the majority of tourists are from abroad. There is no specific prohibition on dressing habits in Bali. It is advisable to wear casual clothing or semi-formal as appropriate.

Currency

A US Dollar is equivalent to around 14,787 IDR and a Euro is around 17,233.4 IDR. For updated information on foreign exchange, please visit <http://www.oanda.com/currency/converter/>

There are IDR 1,000, IDR 2,000, IDR 5,000, Rp 10,000, IDR 20,000, IDR 50,000 and IDR 100,000 notes; and IDR 50, IDR 100, IDR 200, IDR 500, IDR 1000 coins. It is advisable to have your currency converted at the airport since Money Changers are quite far from the venue.

Should you miss having your currency converted in the airport, the nearest Money Changers to the venue of the PGC are:

An ATM Machine is available at Bank Mandiri Taspen which is located beside the venue.

Visa and Mastercard credit cards are accepted in most restaurants and cafes. Cheaper food stalls or “*Warung*” only accept cash.

Language.

English is the common and the most popular foreign language by far after Indonesian and Balinese.

Electrical power and computers.

Expect the 2-pin socket and plug (round) as used in larger parts of Europe. Whether you are staying in a hotel or in a private villa you should be able to get an adapter if you ask for one. The pins are round, not flat or rectangular.

If you come from Australia, Japan, USA, Malaysia, UK, Canada, Singapore, and some countries in Africa you will most likely need a plug adapter otherwise the plugs for your electrical appliances will not fit into the "Bali Socket".

Charging of laptops in the plenary hall and Open Space may be limited. We enjoin everyone to just enjoy listening to the speakers and watching the presentations on the screen. For those facilitating an Open Space, we recommend to bring necessary equipment (laptop, projectors, extension cords, adapter and plugs) if there will be any audio and/or visual presentation. Kits, soft copies and hard copies of any presentation is also encouraged to be provided by the sponsoring organization for Open Space.

Communications

Hotels provide landline, fax, and wifi services.

Good internet connection via local network providers may be availed by purchasing SIM Cards. Please note that **foreign nationals can only buy their SIM Card at the AIRPORT. Government regulations require personal registration of SIM Cards.**

There is no landline, fax, and wifi connection in the RRI Auditorium.

Security
